LOCAL RESOURCES FOR UTILITY ASSISTANCE

SENIOR CITIZENS INC.	ELDERLY/LOW INCOME DISCOUNT	912-236-0363
An elderly/low income credit (billing reduction) is available to qualifying heads of household residing in the City-limits with a City of Savannah residential utility account (water, sewer, refuse) in their name. Qualifying heads of household must be at least 65 years and have a total household income not exceeding poverty levels for the number of occupants in the household as derived from guidelines of the State of Georgia Division of Aging Services. Additional requirements will be provided by the Senior Citizens Inc. in partnership with the City of Savannah.		
L.I.F.E. INC.	DISABLED/LOW INCOME DISCOUNT	912-920-2414
A disabled/low income credit (billing reduction) is available to qualifying individuals with a residential inside City-limits utility account (water, sewer, refuse). Qualifying individuals must be between 18 and 64 years of age and have a low household income that is currently defined as no more than \$958.00 per month if single or \$1293.00 if married. The utility bill must be in the name of the disabled individual or the disabled individual must be the head of the household, and the disabled individual must be receiving Supplemental Security Income (SSI).
