Restrictions: (see Street Performer Policy for full list of restrictions)

Solicitation. At no time shall a Street Performer make oral solicitation or harass the public to pay for performances and/or merchandise. Street Performers may only receive voluntary, non-specified donations and/or gratuities from the public.

Location. Street Performances shall be limited to Forsyth Park, south to the sidewalk abutting the north-side curb line of Park Avenue and the following squares: Johnson, Chippewa and Reynolds. Wright Square will be open to artists and crafters only; provided, however, permittees engaged in such activities may not utilize amplified sound.

Rousakis Plaza. Street Performances may occur in Rousakis Plaza between the Barnard and Abercorn Street ramps on the east and west sides, respectively, the Savannah River on the north, and the sidewalk abutting the north-side curb line abutting the sidewalk of River Street, excluding the ramps and planter boxes.

Conflicting Events. Street Performers, permit notwithstanding, shall yield to scheduled, permitted special events conducted within permitted areas.

Cleanliness. Street Performers shall keep the area in which they perform, to include areas immediately adjacent thereto, clean and free from any litter or debris that may be generated as a consequence of or otherwise associated with their performance. This includes refuse left by patrons and onlookers.
