

2026 - COMMERCIAL DECAL RENEWAL GUIDELINES

Commercial Decal fees are hereby established and required for business vehicles parked in marked freight zones, lanes, or alleys, or at officially bagged parking meters, for loading and unloading merchandise or for providing maintenance, repair, or construction services.

Requirements

- A copy of your paid business tax certificate or license for 2025 or 2026.
- On or after March 1, 2026, only the 2026 certificate will be accepted.
- A copy of the current paid certificate/license if located in another city or county.
- A current tag registration is required for each vehicle purchasing a commercial decal. Tag numbers will be displayed on the commercial decal.
- **Decals will not be issued without current tag registration.**
- **The assigned company or person purchasing commercial decal(s) is responsible for paying all outstanding citations in full before decals can be issued.**
- **Commercial decals will not be mailed and must be picked up at the Mobility & Parking Services office in the Bryan Street Parking Garage at 100 East Bryan Street.**

Cost

- The cost of each commercial decal is \$200.00. As of July 1, one-half of the annual fee for each commercial decal is \$100.00.

Placement of Decal

- The decal must be permanently affixed to the lower front windshield, passenger side.

Placement of Meter Permit (Meter bags are no longer valid)

- The permit must be clearly visible on the passenger side dashboard, next to the Commercial Decal.
- **ONLY VEHICLES THAT QUALIFY WILL BE ELIGIBLE TO PURCHASE A METER PERMIT.**

Charge for Damaged Commercial Decal(s) / Meter Permit(s)

- The charge for a replacement commercial decal shall be \$10.00 if the original is damaged.
- The charge for a replacement meter permit shall be \$25.00 if the original is damaged.
- **The damaged decal or permit must be returned to Mobility & Parking Services to receive the replacement decal or permit.**

Duration

- Commercial decal renewals begin January 1 of each year and expire December 31 of the same year.
- Parking citations for expired commercial decals will be issued beginning February 1 of each year.

Rules and Regulations

- You may not use meter permits or park in lanes unless your activity requires constant access to your vehicle for tools and/or equipment.
- Meter permits may not be used longer than 2 hours without prior approval.
- 15-minute and 30-minute meters/time zones are prohibited.
- Meter permits must be clearly marked with the company name and license plate number.
- Commercial decals cannot be used in a passenger-loading zone.
- Use of freight zones and lanes is prohibited unless active and visible loading, unloading, or servicing is underway.
- If your activity requires you to exceed 30 minutes in a lane, you must contact the Mobility & Parking Services office to request additional time. Citations will be issued to vehicles exceeding the time limit without approval.
- **Freight Zones are limited to 30 minutes maximum**
- **Commercial Decals and/or Meter Permits are PROHIBITED from being reproduced.**
- **It is the responsibility of the company purchasing the decal(s) to provide the above guidelines to their drivers.**
- **Commercial Decals and Commercial Meter Permits are subject to revocation if violations occur.**

METER PERMITS

Vehicle must have a current commercial decal and be inspected and approved by Mobility & Parking Services to qualify for a meter permit.

- The cost of each Meter Permit is \$50.00 per vehicle.
