Dear Disposal Facility Customer,

The annual residential disposal fee for the Dean Forest Road Landfill has been set at \$75.00 by the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Savannah, under the Revenue Ordinance of 2020.

The non-refundable disposal fee must be paid to the City of Savannah's Department of Revenue (**located at 305 Fahm Street in the Coastal Georgia Center**) either in person, or by mail (**P.O. BOX 1228, Savannah, Georgia 31402-1228**). The Department of Revenue hours of operation are Monday-Friday 8:15am-5pm.

Payments will not be accepted at the Dean Forest Road Landfill.

A copy of the enclosed Annual Tipping Fee Credit Form, stamped by the Revenue Department must be presented to the landfill scale attendant as proof of payment.

Upon verification of payment, your name will be entered on a master subscribers' list kept on file at the landfill.

A copy of our Waste Acceptance Policy as well as directions to the Revenue Department are enclosed for your convenience.

DEPARTMENT OF REFUSE DISPOSAL WASTE ACCEPTANCE POLICY

Effective July 1, 2000, public use of the waste drop-off center at the City of Savannah's Dean Forest Road Landfill by persons residing in the unincorporated portions of Chatham County was limited as outlined below.

AUTHORIZED USERS: Services will only be provided to paid subscribers residing within the unincorporated areas of Chatham County for the disposal of waste materials generated within their own domiciles. For the purpose of this policy, domicile is defined as a person's fixed, permanent, principal home for legal purposes.

UNAUTHORIZED USERS: Services will not be provided to persons residing within the corporate limits of Pooler, Port Wentworth, Garden City, Bloomingdale, Thunderbolt, Vernonburg, and Tybee Island. Commercial wastes, including materials originating from the management of rental property, will not be accepted.

ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS: Disposal service is limited to containerized garbage and other containerized items only.

UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS: Dry trash, bulky items, furniture, appliances, uncontainerized garbage, and uncontainerized yard wastes will not be accepted. Commercial wastes, including wastes originating from the management of rental property, will not be accepted. Prohibited wastes, as defined under the Georgia Rules for Solid Waste Management, such as lead-acid batteries will not be accepted.

PAYMENT OF FEES: The nonrefundable annual disposal fee must be paid directly in advance to the City of Savannah's Department of Revenue (located at 305 Fahm Street in the Coastal Georgia Center), either in person or by mail (City of Savannah Department of Revenue, P.O. Box 1228, Savannah, GA 31402-1228)

Payments will not be accepted at the Dean Forest Road Landfill.

A copy of the Annual Tipping Fee Credit Form, stamped by the Revenue Department, must be presented to the landfill scale attendant as proof of payment. Upon verification of payment, customers' names will be entered on a master subscribers list kept on file at the landfill.

ALTERNATE DISPOSAL SITES: Chatham County operates three drop-off centers for the disposal of dry trash, bulky items, furniture, appliances, and yard waste:

- Sharon Park Landfill located on Kelly Hill Road (off U.S. Highway 80, 0.5 miles west of Chatham Parkway)
- Chevis Road Landfill (off U.S. Highway 17, south of Killers Flea Market)
- Wilmington Island Landfill (off Concorde Road)

These facilities are supported by Chatham County property taxes and are available at no additional charge. The facilities are open from 8:00 AM until 5:30 PM Monday through Saturday.

- General City Cashiering



Parking and Public Transit at Coastal Georgia Center

Be sure to park in Revenue customer spots only to avoid parking tickets or towing. Customer parking is in the Visitors Center Lot on the left/east side of the building. Handicap accessible parking is on the right/west side of the building, in the upper lot next to the Coastal Georgia Center. The Customer Entrance/Exit to the building is on the front/north side of the Center. On-site signage will direct you or see the map below.

The Center is two blocks from the CAT Transit Center, where 13 fixed bus routes have a stop. The Transit Center is located at 610 W. Oglethorpe Ave and can be seen on the map below.
