OPTIONS



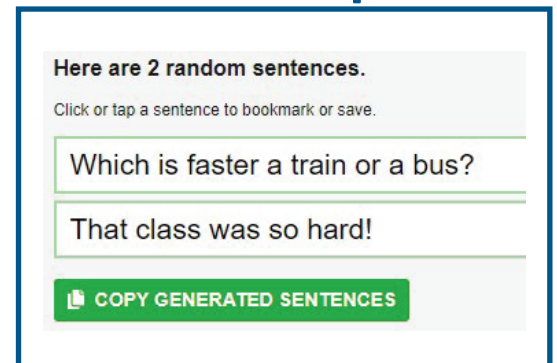
Choose a location for the scene to happen. How does that change what the characters say?
