CITY IN GENERAL

**POPULATION:** 1,036 (1950 U.S. Census), 6,000 summer (Estimated).

**METEOROLOGY:** Prevailing winds S.E. City subject to hurricanes. Winter temperatures are mild, extended periods of hot, dry weather are frequent.

**TOPOGRAPHY:** Grades level about 10' above sea level.

**STREETS:** Approximately 20% streets unimproved.

**FIRE FIGHTING FACILITIES**

**WATER SUPPLY:** Municipally owned. Direct pressure system with supply from deep wells. Total pumping capacity 4,330,000 G. P. D. Total storage capacity 100,000

gallons.

Pressures range from 55 to 65 lbs. with an average of 62 lbs.

Average daily consumption in winter 250,000 gallons, in summer 1,500,000 gallons.

Volunteer with 1 chief, 1 assistant chief and 36 firemen.

2 combination pumper, hose and booster trucks.

Alarm by telephone and siren.
