Words like these used to mean that you and your child had to stay home. But with Bearly Sick, your child’s minor illness doesn’t have to be a major problem.

Bearly Sick at St. Joseph’s/Candler is a child care program for mildly ill children. Your child will get the special attention he or she needs during an illness like a cold or flu.

Bearly Sick was started for our own staff members so that the parents who worked in our hospital could go to work while their sick child was cared for by very qualified people. With our success, we have expanded to reach out to other working parents. It is located adjacent to the Children’s Place with easy access to the Emergency department.

Children ages 3 months to 14 years of age who are too sick to go to school or day care are welcomed Monday through Friday, from 6:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. (Closed on major holidays.)

Guidelines

Please register your child in advance by calling Nurses Station at 819.6215 or Bearly Sick at 819.7382.

Children must be signed in and out by a parent or legal guardian. Unless written authorization is provided in advance, the child will be released only to a parent or legal guardian.

The decision to accept a child for care is based on space availability and assessment by the care giver in charge. Children with highly communicable diseases are not allowed at Bearly Sick.

If your child requires medication you must sign an authorization for the care giver to administer the medication. All prescription (must be in authorized and appropriate labeled containers) and nonprescription medications must be provided by the parent or guardian.

While meals and snacks are included in the fee, diapers, formula, medications, bottles and other personal items must be brought from home.

All children will observe a nap time or quiet period from 12:30 p.m. until 2 p.m.

In the event of a medical emergency, treatment will be provided by St. Joseph’s/Candler, its employees and physicians. A consent for treatment must be signed when you bring your child to Bearly Sick.

An updated copy of the child’s immunization record must be presented upon registration and will be kept on file.



You will receive a report when you pick up your child. This includes evaluation upon admission, medications given, and a summary of activities.

There is a modest fee. Cash or personal checks are taken when you check out. Payroll deduction is available for eligible employees. There are special rates for our managed care partners.

Registration

A registration form is needed for each child before the child will be accepted into the program. This can be completed while your child is healthy or at the time of entrance into the program.
