About the Collection

This record group contains contracts and agreements made by the City with local trades people or outside firms for items as small as the repair of a clock to as large as projects such as the new City Market completed in 1872. Often bids or proposals, both accepted and rejected, are also included with a contract. Around 1879, bond documents are sometimes included. Some contracts are actually acceptance letters for positions with the City. Some contracts are leases for equipment and/or service purchases.

How to Use This Index:

This index will help you discover contracts included in the City Council Meeting Papers – Contracts Collection. It lists the contracts by keyword, grouped alphabetically by the first letter of the keyword, and then numerically by contract number. For example, all the “A” Keywords are grouped together, but they are not listed alphabetically beyond this grouping. Within each letter, the index is arranged by contract number from smallest to largest.

Tips:

- Sometimes there are more entries for a letter than there are lines available on the page, leading to the extra entries being recorded in a different place in the index. Be sure to check the document thoroughly for any overflow entries.
- Contracts may be cataloged by several keywords (ex: by a person’s name AND / OR the location). Brainstorm as many keywords as possible for best results.
- The lower the contract number, the earlier the contract was created. To narrow down the date of the contract, cross reference its number with the Finding Aid (available here: <https://www.savannahga.gov/DocumentCenter/View/498/Contracts?bidId=>)
