Neighborhood History:

The boundaries of the Daffin Heights neighborhood are approximately 56th Street to the north, Skidaway Road to the east, Walz Drive to the south, and Truman Parkway to the west. The neighborhood is commonly identified in a group with the LaRoche Park, Springfield, Wilemere and Shirely Park neighborhoods. This area came into the Savannah City limits in 1950.

The boundaries of the Sunset Park neighborhood are approximately Skidaway Road on the west, Victory Drive between Skidaway and the City Limits on the north, the City Limits on the east, and Country Drive on the south. The neighborhood is commonly identified in a group with the Fernwood and Parkwood neighborhoods. This area came into the Savannah City limits in 1961.

Both neighborhoods primarily consist of single-family homes and were developed in the mid-20th century.

Scope and Content:

The Daffin Heights and Sunset Park Community Collection was created through the Savannah Community Memory Project District Five collecting event in early 2024. The collection contains two folders of written reflection prompt cards from area residents.

Files are arranged alphabetically by related neighborhood.
