***Custodial History:***

The Clemmons family collection records were discovered in the Clemmons home in Savannah at 2201 East Victory Drive before it was demolished in 2017. At that time, the records were deposited at the Thunderbolt Museum. In July 2024, the collection was gifted by the Thunderbolt Museum to the Municipal Archives. Select original awards and digital reproductions of photographs and publications were returned to the Thunderbolt Museum.

***Biographical History:***

John Benjamin Clemmons Sr. was born on April 11, 1912 in Rome Georgia. In 1927, John completed tenth grade and graduated from Rome Colored High School<sup>1</sup>. John enrolled at Morehouse College where he earned a Bachelor of Science degree. The collection includes John's diplomas from Morehouse dated to 1930 and 1936. He then earned a Master of Science degree in 1937 from Atlanta University. John began his career in Harlan, Kentucky where he was a teacher and later a school principal. He married his wife, Mozelle Dailey, in the late 1940s. The couple moved to Savannah in 1947 where John began teaching at Savannah State College (now Savannah State University). In the early 1950s he began working on his Ph.D. at the University of Southern California then transferred to University of California, Los Angeles. He then returned to Savannah and continued teaching at Savannah State College where he was a professor of mathematics and physics. He later became the chairman of Mathematics and Physics Department at Savannah State College. In 1960, John Clemmons became the Director of Carver State Bank and he remained on the Board of Directors of the bank until 2012. Mr. Clemmons was a charter member of Alpha Mu Boule which was established January 28, 1963. At the time of his death, he was a member of Alpha Lambda Boule, Savannah, Georgia and had served on the national executive board of Sigma Pi Phi Fraternity. He also served as a Trustee of the Boule Foundation. John Clemmons Sr. was active in many civic, civil rights, and business organizations in Savannah including the Boy Scouts, Goodwill Industries, Inc., Memorial Medical Center, Saint Phillip AME Church, and the Savannah Branch of the NAACP. John won an NAACP Freedom Award from the Savannah Branch in 2003. John Clemmons Sr. passed away on June 13, 2012 at the age of 100. He is buried at Hillcrest Abbey East Cemetery.

Mozelle Dailey Clemmons was born on December 24, 1921. She graduated from Spellman College in Atlanta in 1943. She met and married John B. Clemmons Sr. in Harlan, Kentucky in the late 1940s. She started teaching language arts at Sophronia

Tompkins High School in Savannah from around 1956 through at least 1986. Later, she worked at the Chatham County School Employees Federal Credit Union. She was an active member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority Inc. Savannah Alumnae Chapter. Mozelle served as the twelfth president of the Chapter from 1965-1967. Mozelle dedicated her life to the fight for Civil Rights and the preservation of African American history and culture in Savannah. She was the first Vice President of the Savannah Branch of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People. She started the organization's Freedom Fund dinner in 1981 and ran it for 16 years. She received the NAACP Freedom Award from the Savannah Branch in 1994 for "exceptional leadership and courage." Al Scott, former Chatham County Commission chairman and president of the Savannah Branch NAACP, said about Mozelle Clemmons "In my opinion, she and Esther Garrison were the two most important women of civil rights during the era." Mozelle was also a founding member of the King-Tisdell Foundation and was instrumental in preserving the King-Tisdell Cottage. She also was active in the American Cancer Society, March of Dimes, Greenbriar Children's Center, Savannah Symphony, Chatham-Savannah Citizens Advocacy, Union Camp Advisory Board and Savannah Landmark Association, and St. Paul's CME Church. Mozelle passed away on January 4, 2016. She is buried at Hillcrest Abbey East Cemetery.

John and Mozelle had two children, Sheila Clemmons (1948-2015) and John Benjamin Clemmons, Jr. (1949-). Sheila Clemmons was born on April 12, 1948 in Savannah. She passed away on May 14, 2015 and is buried at Hillcrest Abbey East Cemetery. John Jr. was born in Savannah in 1949. He graduated from Williams College in 1971 for his undergraduate education, then went to Howard University College of Medicine for medical school, where he graduated in 1975. He completed his internal medicine internship, residency, and a gastroenterology fellowship at Emory University in Atlanta. Dr. Clemmons was the first African American to train in gastroenterology at Emory University. As of 2024, he resides and practices medicine in Houston, Texas. He was married to Lora Randle Clemmons (1952-2018).

***Scope & Content:***

The Clemmons family collection (1929-2006, no date) contains certificates, plaques, awards, photographs, news clippings, publications, and personal writings from or related to the life and work of John B. Clemmons Sr., Mozelle Clemmons, John B. Clemmons Jr., and Sheila Clemmons. The awards and certificates document John Sr.'s academic, professional, and volunteer accomplishments, as well as the many community organizations that Mozelle was involved with, and John Jr.'s academic and professional accomplishments. Highlights of the awards and certificates include: John Sr.'s diplomas from Morehouse College and Atlanta University; and the NAACP Freedom Awards given to John Sr. and Mozelle Clemmons. The photographs include individual and family portraits of the Clemmons family, as well as images of John Sr.'s Boy Scout activities and John Jr.'s travels. Highlights of the photographs are images of a Boy Scout Troop trip to Texas and New Mexico in 1964 and an album of photographs from John Jr.'s travels to Greece and Egypt. The publications and manuscript materials include a
