



SAINT PATRICK'S HAWKERS/STREET VENDOR PERMIT INFORMATION

PLEASE READ BEFORE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

Saint Patrick's FAQs

1. When can I submit my application to participate in the Festival? **February 18, 2025**
2. How can I obtain an application for the event? **Via website, mail, or pick-up in person**
3. When will applications be available? **Applications will be available online at www.savannahga.gov/stpats or 305 Fahm St. from February 18th to March 12, 2025.**
4. I am a mobile vendor; what days can I sell during the Saint Patrick's Festival? **Hawkers' permits are only good for March 17, 2025. No additional days are permitted for Hawkiers.**
5. What are the fees for a permit? **Fees for a Hawker range from \$35.00 to \$120.00**
6. What form of payment is accepted? **Cash, Money Order, Credit Card only**
7. I want to sell food/nonfood from a site; does the City of Savannah provide sites for selling? **The City of Savannah does not assign fixed locations. The business owner would be required to obtain an approved location for vending.**
8. Where can I peddle my merchandise? **The following streets, sidewalks, and public ways are off-limits to peddlers, festival hawkers, or street vendors: The River Street "controlled" festival zone; all of the area north of the south curb line of Bay Street; all City Parks and Squares; all of the City Market areas bordered by Bryan Street on the north, Congress Street on the south, Barnard Street on the east, and Montgomery Street on the west; and the traffic lanes along the designated parade route when and where the parade is in progress.**
9. What are the times for vendors operating as a Hawker? **7 am-8 pm**
10. What is the deadline to apply? **All applications must be received by the Revenue Department at 305 Fahm Street by 5:00 pm on Wednesday, March 12, 2025. All hawkers' permits will be available for pick-up at the Savannah Civic Center, 301 W. Oglethorpe Ave., between 6 am and 8 am on March 17, 2025.**
11. My business operates as a Non-profit; do I need a BTC? **Yes, with proof of IRS 501(c)(3). (Max of 10 hawker permits per non-profit organization).**
12. Can I share my permit with my co-worker? **No, each person with merchandise must have a hawker's permit and ID.**
13. What if my permit is lost or stolen? **No duplicate permit will be issued.**
14. What if my merchandise is confiscated? When can I pick it up? **You can pick up your merchandise on Monday, March 17, 2025, at the Savannah Civic Center Mason room between 1:00pm-3:00pm.**
15. Can someone pick up my permit? **Yes, providing proof of your original ID.**
