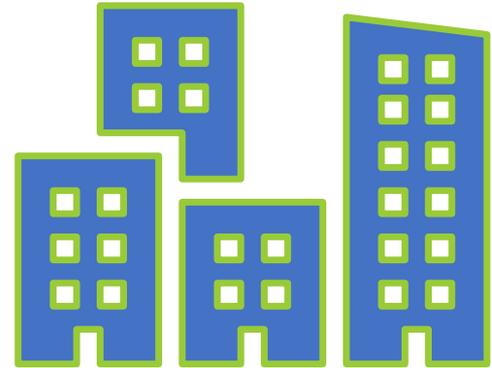
REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

Purchase of programs and services

- Assist in achieving the goals and priorities identified by the City of Savannah
- Support and specifically benefit the residents of Savannah, Georgia

Successful proposals will be recommended for funding

- \$15,000 to \$50,000 for Community Services Contracts
- Up to \$200,000 for Homeless Continuum of Care Management



Agencies submitting proposals must meet the following requirements:

AGENCY ELIGIBILITY

- Be a legally formed (provide documentation) not-for-profit located within the city and providing services which support and directly benefit residents of Savannah.
- Provide proof of the non-profit entity's legal formation. Both non-profit and for-profit corporations are formed in Georgia by filing with the Corporations Division of the Office of Secretary of State.

NOTE: Agencies approved for 2026 must provide proof of IRS federal tax exemption prior to contract execution.

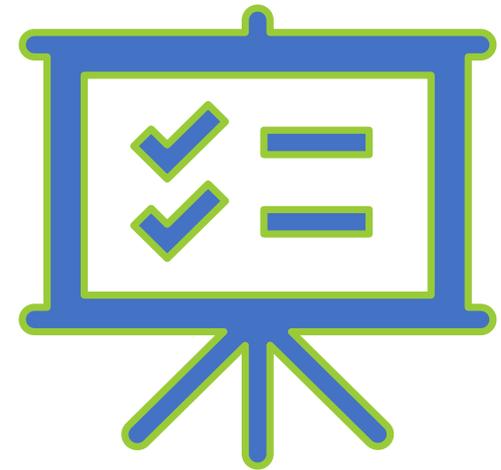
Agencies submitting proposals must meet the following requirements:

AGENCY ELIGIBILITY

- Agencies requesting \$25,000 or more must submit a profit and loss statement or financial statements prepared by an Independent Auditor or Certified Public Accountant in accordance with generally accepted auditing principles.
- For agencies requesting less than \$25,000 a profit and loss statement prepared by the agency and a full copy of the agency's Form 990 submission to the IRS for the last completed tax season will be accepted.
- Any areas of concern identified in the agency's profit and loss statement, Form 990, or summary of reviewed financial statement will be addressed during the proposal review period and in consultation with the City of Savannah's Office of Management and Budget.

EVALUATION

- The Community Partnership Program is a competitive process.
- Proposals will be evaluated by one or more selection committees according to the criteria outlined in the Request for Proposals.
- Proposals may or may not be recommended for funding; therefore, agencies should not rely upon or have an expectation of funding from the City of Savannah.
- The final funding decision is made by the Savannah City Council.



SCORING CRITERIA

- ▶ **COMMUNITY NEEDS & PROBLEM STATEMENT** **15 points**

Applications should demonstrate knowledge of specific local conditions and needs that the program will address. Provide quantitative data on the people in Savannah experiencing these conditions, quote the source of the data, and give the number of persons/families the proposed program will service.
- ▶ **BUDGET/FINANCIALS** **25 points**

The organization budget must reflect diverse funding sources and a strong capacity to manage resources. It is important that the City of Savannah is not the primary funding source.
- ▶ **BENEFIT OF PROGRAM/SERVICE TO PARTICIPANTS** **10 points**

The proposed program or service must result in outcomes that addresses community needs.

SCORING CRITERIA (cont'd)

- ▶ **PROGRAM DESIGN** **20 points**
The program/service must be fully developed and well-defined.
- ▶ **COST PER PROGRAM PARTICIPANT** **10 Points**
This ratio is determined by dividing the total program funding request by the number of participants to be served who reside within the city of Savannah.
- ▶ **OPERATIONAL CAPACITY AND PROGRAM EXPERIENCE** **15 points**
Agencies must demonstrate the capacity to deliver the proposed program or service as evidenced by the agency's years in operation and experience.
- ▶ **COLLABORATIONS/PARTNERSHIPS** **5 Points**
Collaborations and partnerships which benefit program participants and connect participants to additional resources is a City priority.

HELPFUL TIPS

- **Do not repeat the same information in multiple question responses.**
- **Funding recommendations are based on information included in the application submitted. If approved, major changes are not permitted.**
- **The evaluation committee members may not know your organization. Do not assume they know industry lingo or jargon.**
- **Do not falsify information in your application, you may be disqualified.**

HELPFUL TIPS

➤ BUDGET/FINANCIALS

- Detailed, clear and consistent throughout the application
- Verified against your last Form 990 and financial statements.

➤ COST PER PROGRAM PARTICIPANT

- Total amount requested divided by # served
- This is tax-payer money, consider... would you purchase this service?

➤ DIVERSE FUNDING SOURCES

- The City of Savannah should **not** be the sole funding source.

HELPFUL TIPS

HOMELESS ASSISTANCE SERVICES

If your agency is seeking a grant for homeless assistance services, your application **must be submitted through the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) application process (closes June 16, 2025, at 5:00PM) or the Day Center Mini-Grant Program application (closes July 28, 2025, at 5:00PM).**



NOTE: The Community Partnership Program **does not fund** homeless assistance programs and activities.

HELPFUL TIPS

APPLICATION SUBMISSION TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

June 12 – July 21 by email ONLY at: support@neighborlysoftware.com

- Identify Case ID# in subject line
- Include contact name and phone #
- Response usually within 24 hours

ACCESSING THE PORTAL

- Register your account by clicking on the Register link.
- Registration will create a username (which is your email address) and password that will be used for future logins. *The email address you choose will be used for system emails/notifications, so it is recommended you use your work email.*
- The system will validate that you own the registered email by sending a validation link email/code.
