CHANCEL OF THE LUTHERAN CHURCH OF THE ASCENSION

The chancel is shown as reconstructed in 1921, with marble floor and wainscot, and beautiful marble altar portraying the Lord's Supper in high relief. The decorations, done in 1921, were renewed in 1934. The Ascension window, now a valuable antique, was installed in 1879. The console of the three manual Skinner organ is placed in the recess on the right and is connected with pipes located on both sides of the chancel and in the tower of the church. The pulpit, lectern and floor candelabra are of bronze.



MICKVE ISRAEL TEMPLE


Designed by architect D.M. Foley and dedicated in 1878, Mickve Israel Temple is the only Gothic style synagogue in the U.S. The floor plan has the shape of a Christian cross but the star of David above the entrance reveals the building's true identity. This is the third oldest Jewish congregation in the country – formed after the 1733 arrival of 42 Ashkenazic and Sephardic Jewish colonists. A 1926 fire destroyed the original 14th century style Gothic tower and Morton Levy was architect for the Moorish type minaret replacement steeple. Torahs from 1733 and 1737 are among the congregation's most treasured possessions.




Chancel of the Lutheran Church of the Ascension - Savannah, Ga



CHANCEL OF THE LUTHERAN CHURCH
OF THE ASCENSION

The chancel is shown as reconstructed in 1921, with marble floor and wainscot, and beautiful marble altar portraying the Lord's Supper in high relief. The decorations, done in 1921, were renewed in 1934. The Ascension window, now a valuable antique, was installed in 1879. The console of the three manual Skinner organ is placed in the recess on the right and is connected with pipes located on both sides of the chancel and in the tower of the church. The pulpit, lecturn and floor candelabra are of bronze.
