## JAMES EDWARD OGLETHORPE

James Edward Oglethorpe is known as the founder of Georgia. He landed with approximately 114 colonists in early February 1733. The town site had already been selected by Oglethorpe in a friendly negotiation with the local Indian leader of the Yamacraws. The monument to J. E. Oglethorpe is located in Chippewa Square at Bull and McDonough Streets. It was erected by the State of Georgia and the City of Savannah in 1910. The 9 foot bronze statue is the work of Daniel Chester French, one of America's foremost sculptors. The pedestal and base of the monument was designed by Henry Bacon, who had collaborated with Mr. French to do the Lincoln Memorial. Oglethorpe was responsible for the way the city of Savannah's streets and lots were planned. It was patterned after the Georgian town squares of England. By the year 1858, there were 24 such squares in the city. Oglethorpe returned to England after spending only 1 year in Savannah.
