

The Flag of the Pulaski Legion, a Cavalry Guard of crimson silk with designs and letters in yellow silk shaded in green, was embroidered by the Sisters of the Moravian Community of Bethlehem, Pennsylvania, for General Casimir Pulaski's Independent Legion in 1778 during the American Revolution. The Polonia of Chester, Pennsylvania, has rescued this banner from its consignment to oblivion by establishing a new tradition of presenting an authentic replica of the original to meritorious recipients at the Annual Chester Pulaski Day Parade.
