***Organizational History:***

In 1925, the Bacon Park Commission was established by an act of the Georgia legislature. This Commission consisted of seven people to manage and care for the public park and municipal golf course known as Bacon Park (Georgia Laws, 1925, p. 1440). The municipal golf course was originally designed as an 18 hole-course in 1926 by renowned architect Donald Ross. In 1985, the course was expanded to 27 holes. In February 1989, the American Golf Corporation assumed the management responsibility for the course. In 2008, the Bacon Park Golf Course was under the supervision of the Leisure Services Bureau, with daily operations and management handled by the private firm of EDR Management, Inc.
