Scope and Content:

Record Series 5100-025, Savannah Fire and Emergency Services Bureau Records, Visual Materials-Architectural Drawings (circa 1904-circa 1999, no date), includes architectural drawings of buildings and technical drawings of apparatus. The items in this series include plans and proposals for fire stations, plans for city and non-city buildings that were used for pre-fire planning and inspections, and drawings of two fire trucks. Neither apparatus drawing is for SFES equipment—one is a proposed truck, and the other is an example of a truck built for another city. There is also some text, including several documents related to the Georgia International and Maritime Trade Center.
