**Scope and Content:**

Record Series 5100-026, Savannah Fire and Emergency Services Bureau Records, Visual Materials-Maps (1966-1994, no date), includes maps relating to the City of Savannah. The materials include maps that show Savannah's city limits, street names, building footprints, water main lines and hydrants, city wells and pumping stations, and what streets are paved. Many of these maps are not dated and lack point-of-origin or creator information. There is also one item of text, *Savannah's Great Fires*, that uses maps and text to describe some of Savannah's biggest fires.
