Proclamation

WHEREAS: it is the custom and policy of the City of Savannah to take note of the accomplishments and contributions of its citizens that are of unusual benefit to the peace, tranquility and progress of the City; and

WHEREAS: Westley W. Law through his years of leadership of the Savannah Branch National Association for the Advancement of Colored People and through his exercise of leadership in general in the entire black community, has done much to enhance interracial understanding and tolerance among the citizens of Savannah; and

WHEREAS: Westley W. Law has further demonstrated his pride in our community by his comprehensive knowledge of its history and traditions, and by his enthusiastic support of the cultural arts that characterize our City.

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of Savannah and in recognition of his accomplishments and contributions as mentioned above, I hereby proclaim March 19, 1977 to be

"WESTLEY W. LAW DAY"

in the City of Savannah.
